



Snow Removal Routes

Roadways are prioritized in a manner to move as much traffic as possible in as safe a manner as possible. Snow removal exercises will generally be completed as designated on the Snow Removal Routes map and generally in the following order:

- Primary Routes will be cleared first and remain the top priority. Crews may be moved back to Primary Routes from Secondary or other routes as conditions warrant.
 - Secondary Routes will be cleared after Primary Routes followed by other routes if resources are available.
 - Cul-de-sac's will only be plowed if conditions and resources warrant an effective treatment option.
 - Commercial lots or private streets and drives will not be plowed.
 - Certain drives will be cleared of snow windrows from plowing if written medical conditions of the home owner (received from the medical provider) warrant such actions. Medical condition exceptions do not guarantee snow removal on the street, rather alerts city crews not to block the driveway with the plowed snow. These must be renewed annually.
- Salt, rock and other treatments will be applied at the discretion of the Street Superintendent.
