

Issue: AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIXA AMENDING

CHAPTER 2 OF THE NIXA CITY CODE BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION PROVIDING FOR THE WAIVER OF USER FEES BY

Background

Frequently, City Council will, by motion, waive certain municipal user fees. This practice exposes the City to liability under the Sunshine Law and the First Amendment.

Analysis

Council Bill 2021-114 is presented to formalize the Council's practice into a more legally sound process. This Bill would amend the City Code to authorize the Council to waive user fees for other government organizations by Resolution.

Recommendation

Adopting and adhering to this Ordinance will help the City avoid certain claims under the Sunshine Law and the First Amendment, therefore, staff recommends approval.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIXA AMENDING CHAPTER 2 OF THE NIXA CITY CODE BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION PROVIDING FOR THE WAIVER OF USER FEES BY RESOLUTION.

WHEREAS the City of Nixa charges various municipal user fees for providing certain services and approvals; and

WHEREAS the City Council desires to implement a procedure whereby other governmental entities may request waivers of the City's user fees; and

WHEREAS such waivers must be acted on by the Council via Resolution and only after a showing that the public is better served by the requested fee waiver; and

WHEREAS because the City's governmental community partners are also supported by the taxpayer funding, the Council desires to authorize the waiver of user fees in the manner described herein to utilize taxpayer funding more efficiently.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NIXA, AS FOLLOWS, THAT:

SECTION 1: Chapter 2, Article IV of the Nixa City Code is hereby amended by adding thereto one new section, which said section shall read as follows:

(Note: Language to be added is indicated by being underlined. Language to be removed is indicated by being stricken.)

Sec. 2-151. – Waiver of fees for governmental entities by resolution – authorized.

No municipal user fees, whether imposed by this code or any other ordinance shall be waived except by Resolution of the City Council. The Council shall only waive such fees by Resolution for other governmental entities and upon a showing by said governmental entity that the public is better served by the requested waiver than by the imposition of the fee.

SECTION 2: The City Attorney, when codifying the provisions of this Ordinance, is authorized to provide for different section numbers, subsection numbers, and different internal citation references than those provided herein when such section numbers, subsection numbers, or internal citation references are in error or are contrary to the intent of this Ordinance.

SECTION 3: Savings Clause. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to affect any suit or proceeding now pending in any court or any rights acquired, or liability incurred nor any cause or causes of action occurred or existing, under any act or ordinance repealed hereby.

SECTION 4: Severability Clause. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or 47 phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid, such decision shall not affect 48 the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.
