

RE: 2023 BUDGETARY AMENDMENT FOR THE REINSTATEMENT OF A UTILITY BILLING ACCOUNT SPECIALIST I POSITION.

Background:

Since 2020, the Utility Billing office has gone through several staff changes. In 2020, staffing levels were as follows: 1 Supervisor, 1 Assistant Supervisor, 2 UB Account Specialist II and 2 Account Specialist I, for a total of 6 office staff. In 2021, an open position for Account Specialist I was never filled due to a restructuring of duties and assignments. However, since that time the volume of work has increased with the addition of the RDE and Tuscany Hills systems and the general growth of the City. The number of electric meters billed has increased by 6% from 10,756 in 2020 to 11,352 as of April of 2023. The number of water meters billed has increased 19% from 9,214 in 2020 to 10,957 as of April of 2023. That, coupled with some additional staff turnover, has left the remaining staff stretched very thin.

Analysis:

In order to provide the best customer service and most accurate billing, the Utility Billing office needs to revert to the previous staffing levels of 6 instead of 5.

Recommendation:

Staff recommends passage.

17	WHEREAS the City Council desires to amend the City's 2023 budget for the

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23	SECTION 1: The City of Nixa's 2023 Annual Budget is hereby amended in the
24	accounts and the amounts as shown on "Council Bill Exhibit A," which is attached hereto
25	and incorporated herein by this reference.
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27	SECTION 2: City Council finds that the budget amendment enacted by this
28	Ordinance has been recommended by the City Administrator. The City Administrator is
29	directed to cause the appropriate accounting entries to be made in the books and records
30	of the City to reflect the budget amendment enacted by this Ordinance.
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32	SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its final
33	passage by the City Council and after its approval by the Mayor, subject to the provisions
34	of section 3.11(g) of the City Charter.
