## **Background**

As a part of the 2025 parks department budget a \$150,000 to begin work at the Eoff Family Century Farm Park. The plan for this first round of funding is to install a parking lot/trial head and some of the trails to get the public on the North parcel of the park land. Staff has been working with Show Me Christian County and a professional grant writer to assist in the application of a Recreational Trails Program Grant offered through the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Division of State Parks. This grant would allow the city to stretch its funding to provide more opportunities for access of this park.

## <u>Analysis</u>


The Recreational Trails Program (RTP) allows for grant applications to be submitted now through March 3<sup>rd</sup> 2025. This is a matching grant with a minimum match of 20%, however more points are awarded for matches up to 40% or greater, with a maximum request of \$250,000. Staff intends to apply for \$250,000 for this grant, using our \$150,000 as the 60% matching funds. As we progress through the year we will be able to engineer this project in the coming months, with grant award notifications occurring in October 2025. If awarded we will work through the necessary elements to receive the project "go" which would not occur until early 2026. Where we would have the engineering completed, this would be the only step we could accomplish prior to the grant award, thus remaining funds would need to be carried over to 2026 for this project.

## **Recommendation**

Staff is requesting permission to apply for and if awarded accept funding from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources Recreational Trails Program in the 2025 grant cycle. Staff believes this opportunity will provide a great avenue for the city and parks department to stretch its funding to accomplish more within the park for the community.
