Job Summary: Performs a variety of general cleaning, maintenance, operation, construction, and repair tasks for the City water, wastewater, street, or storm drainage facilities.

An employee in this position may be called upon to do any or all of the following essential duties:

- Participates in wastewater treatment and collections system, construction and maintenance of assigned department.
- Assists other City workers in general activities or grounds maintenance.
- Operates automotive and motorized equipment, which may include but not limited to air compressor, backhoe, dump truck, pickup truck, lawnmower, end loader, fork lift, snowplows, and water truck; utilizes a variety of power and hand tools.
- Effectively perform as a member of a team in carrying out the City's organizational development plan philosophy.
- Perform other tasks and duties assigned by supervision.
