Job Summary: Performs a variety of general maintenance, operation, and repair tasks for the City's water distribution utility and other functions of the Water Quality Department.

Essential Job Functions

An employee in this position may be called upon to do any or all of the following essential duties:

- Participates in water and wastewater system facilities construction and maintenance of the Water Quality Department and assist other City workers in general activities or grounds maintenance.
- Operates automotive and motorized equipment, which may include an air compressor, backhoe, dump truck, pickup truck, lawnmower, end loader, fork lift, asphalt roller, short and long brush truck, street sweeper, snowplows, dozer, motor grader, street striping machine, and water truck; utilizes a variety of power and hand tools.
- Effectively perform as a member of a team in carrying out the City's organizational development plan philosophy.
- Perform other tasks and duties assigned.

Essential Functions, Qualifications, Knowledge, Skills, and Abilities (KSA's) for Employment

An employee in this class must have the following knowledge, skills, and abilities upon application:

Knowledge

- Occupational hazards and safe working practices.
- Methods, equipment, and materials for water, wastewater, street or storm drainage maintenance, cleaning, repair, and construction.
- Principles of general labor, construction, and landscape using general construction equipment.
- Principles of customer service and meeting quality standards.

Skills

- Oral and written communications.
- Establishing and maintaining effective working relationships with other staff, and members of the public.
- Operating a variety of automotive, motorized, and hand-held equipment.

- Stooping, climbing, and bending.
